1 What is it?

Crush Cancer is a local rare cancer research FUNdraising event benefiting Cycle for Survival, the national movement to beat rare cancers. We have raised over \$2,100,000 since 2015 and are so excited to keep the momentum going.

2 How does it work?

Crush Cancer and Cycle for Survival's high-energy outdoor team spin-cycling events provide a tangible way to fight back against cancer— 100% of all money raised by team participants directly funds lifesaving rare cancer research. The organizing committee is 100% volunteers, and Corporate Sponsorship is utilized to cover Crush Cancer's event costs with all surplus corporate sponsorship contributed to fund rare cancer research.

3 What will change?

100% of every donation by team participants in Crush Cancer is directly allocated to research through Cycle for Survival at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. The donations go to pioneering research and clinical trials, and have already led to new and better treatments for cancer patients worldwide. Memorial Sloan Kettering researchers collaborate with institutions around the world, and have led the way in developing new ways to diagnose and treat cancer.

Rare cancers affect approximately 50% of people diagnosed with cancer. Many of these diseases are familiar—such as leukemia and lymphoma, all pediatric cancers, brain, ovarian, and pancreatic cancers, among many others—and they may have hit too close to home for you, too.
